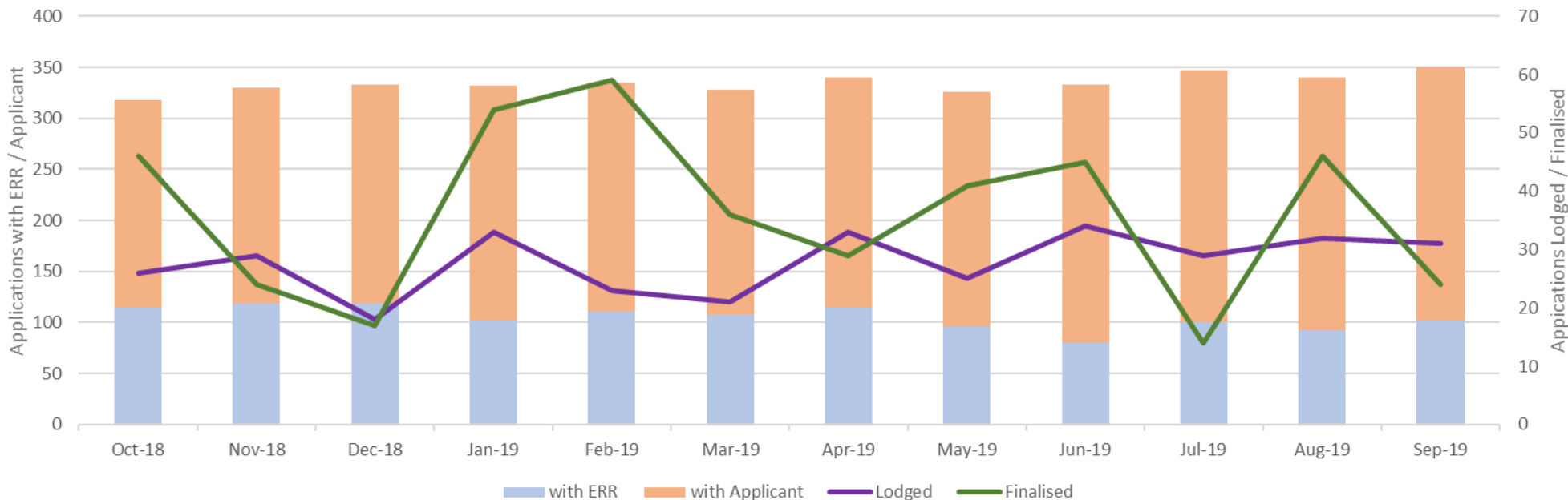

Median Days #: Arranging the stage duration in order and then selecting the one in the middle duration. Median is used to minimise the impact of outliers.

No. Work Plans*: The number of work plans that had that stage assessed in the year. A single Work Plan in Oct can have had a stage assessed multiple times.
